

Grade 3: Weekly Phonics Focus Lesson 4

In our classroom this week, we are reviewing how to read and spell words with <u>vowel-r</u> <u>patterns *e-r*, *i-r*, and *u-r*</u>. Here are the letters and patterns to practice this week:

Consonants	b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, z y at the beginning of a word
Vowels	a, e, i, o, u y at the end of a word
Closed Syllables	Closed syllable words have 1 vowel letter followed by 1 or more consonants and the vowel sound is short.
Vowel-r Syllables	Vowel-r syllables have 1 vowel sound spelled with 1 or 2 vowels and the consonant r, which affects the way the vowel sound is pronounced.
	 The 3 vowel-r patterns in this lesson are spelled differently but pronounced the same: The vowel-r patterns <i>e-r</i>, <i>i-r</i>, and <i>u-r</i> spell the /er/ sound, as in the keyword <i>bird</i>. The most common spelling for /er/ is e-r, followed by i-r, and then u-r.

(*Note:* A letter in slashes, such as /s/, indicates that the letter sound rather than the letter name should be said.)

Here are some examples of words with the patterns we are reviewing:

er		ir		Ur	
germ	stern	first	girl	hurt	curb

Below is an activity to practice at home this week. You may also use the activities and questions from the initial *Family Support Letter* to further address your child's success in learning the weekly phonics focus.

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Word Sort

Guide your child through this Word Sort by saying, "Let's sort words." Read these steps to your child:

- 1. Find the vowel in the word.
- 2. Is the single vowel letter followed by the consonant *r*?
- 3. Identify the syllable type as vowel-r or closed and say the vowel sound.
- 4. Read the word and then write it in the correct column below.

As you read and write with your child this week, be on the lookout for words with **vowel-r patterns** *e-r*, *i-r*, and *u-r* and *closed syllable* words. Add the pattern words you and your child find to the correct column in the chart above.

Word Sort Answer Key: Vowel-r Syllables: (er) perch, her; (ir) shirt; (ur) turn; Closed Syllables: rust /ŭ/, dress /ĕ/

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
