## Grade 3: Weekly Phonics Focus Lesson 18

In our classroom this week, we will review how to read and spell words with the <u>unpredictable</u> <u>vowel team syllable pattern</u>. Here is the pattern to practice this week:

- 3. If the most common pronunciation does not make sense, swap the sound and read the phrase again.
